# Why participate?

# What are the benefits?

At the end of the Challenge, participants will:

- have an improved knowledge of management techniques

# Getting Started

## 1. Register a Team

## Investment

## 2. Choose a Team and a Mentor

Team members do not have to be senior personnel – they can and are often from throughout the entire organisation. Historically the teams that have gained the most from the experience are those that are the most diverse in terms of participant's job function, level and experience. Teams can include 4-6 members.

There is no disadvantage in having a team of 4.

**The team also needs a mentor** – someone who can, with material supplied by the LG Professionals SA guide the team through the preparation phase.
