Mayor Angela Evans, City of Charles Sturt

Mayor Angela Evans has been leading the City of Charles Sturt since the November 2014 Local Government Elections. In her term as Mayor, she has overseen the redevelopment of major Charles Sturt precincts including the award winning \$8.4m Henley Square Precinct and participates in the AdeLINK Mayoral Group to further the light rail vision for Charles Sturt. She is also a passionate driver behind placemaking initiatives aimed at supporting grassroots communities to be collaborative and innovative.

Angela has experience in the business sector as a small business operator and has extensive experience working within the Community Service sector.



Mayor Karen Redman, Town of Gawler

Mayor Karen Redman holds a Masters qualification in health and has had long time involvement in the area by contributing to community groups, mainly children's sporting activities.

In 2010, Karen decided to get involved in local affairs, and was elected as a council member, which led her to run for Mayor in 2014. She was fortunate to be elected on a platform of a stronger presence in the region for Gawler, given its growth; and a cultural heritage and economic development agenda.

Since becoming Mayor, major achievements for the Town of Gawler have included the successful grant funding for the Gawler Connect project, the Gawler East Link road alignment and progression, China engagement, with a cultural exchange with Penglai. Most recently, Karen was elected to the Local Government Association (LGA) Board and is Chair of the Metropolitan Local Government Group (MLGG).

Cr Jennie Boisvert has been a Ward Councillor in Goodwood South / Clarence Park for over 13 years and has lived in the ward for the last 34 years where she has raised a family with her husband.
