Network Eligibility:

Distance shouldn't be a barrier to getting involved. Per the People and Culture Network Committee Terms of Reference, minimum committee meeting attendance requirements apply.

- Biennial People and Culture Network Conference
- Supporting LG Professionals SA in delivery of Strategic Plan initiatives
